

# Tips for Hurricane Preparation and Safety

## BEFORE

- **Stay informed** by following weather reports, news, and signing up for local alerts and warnings.
- **Get supplies.** This includes, but is not limited to: food (canned goods, dry goods), water, gas, cash, batteries, flashlights, generator, etc.
- **Safeguard your property** by securing any loose items in your yard, to protect from wind or damage. Board up and secure your windows, roof and other structures. Find a safe, dry location for your valuables.
- **Prepare to evacuate** by knowing the local evacuation routes, having a place to re-locate to and stay, and packing a bag of necessities.
- **Create your online policyholder account.** Not only can you access your policy to view coverages, make payments and more, but you can also report a claim quickly and easily after the storm. Once a claim is submitted, you can check your claim status on your account.

## DURING

- **Stay safe!** Above all else.
- **Listen** to local authorities, and evacuate if asked to.
- **Exercise caution** at all times. Keep away from windows. Stay in an interior room. Do not walk or drive in dangerous conditions.

## AFTER

- **Stay alert**, and continue to be safe. Avoid flooded roads and downed trees, poles, and power lines.
- **Return to your home** once local authorities deem it is safe.
